MOBILITY SUPPORT

Assistance Dogs help people who are living with physical disabilities like quadriplegia, cerebral palsy, and muscular dystrophy. Our highly trained Assistance Dogs pick up dropped items, open doors and drawers, and give emotional support so their humans can live more independently. With your support, people who need mobility support can finally be in charge of their own lives.

POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER (PTSD)

The horror of PTSD can paralyse a person to the point of extreme disruption of day-to-day functioning, relationships, and work. An Assistance Dog helps to detect and stop PTSD symptoms before they overwhelm their human. Lives can be rebuilt with the confidence and safety that Assistance Dogs bring.

AUTISM

The autism spectrum is wide and varied, so Autism Assistance Dogs are specially trained to address the specific needs of each person so they can have an even brighter and happier future. Autism Assistance Dogs bring breakthroughs in people who are having a meltdown, are non-verbal, have sensory issues, struggle with social skills, or are just not responding to other therapy.





EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT

Educational Support Dogs provide support to students in many ways, including offering emotional support, recognising signs of anxiety and helping improve concentration and communication skills. They also help to reduce the incidence of antisocial behaviour and bullying. Students are happier and more focussed with an Educational Support Dog in the classroom.
